Superscript note explanations:

- 1 Legal Research & Writing (OCT) begins 10/7/19-ends mid-December; Introduction to Law (OCT) begins 10/8/19 - ends mid-December.
- 2 Law Study & Exams - session starts 10/3/19 and ends 12/12/19, then restarts 1/9/20 and ends 2/6/20.
- 3 Legal Aid Clinic - option to take for 2 or 3 units
