**Superscript note explanations:**

- 1 Legal Research & Writing (FEB) begins week of Feb 1, 2021 and ends mid-April, 2021; Introduction to Law (FEB) begins week of Feb 1, 2021 and ends mid-April, 2021;
- 2 Law Study & Exams - Continuing session restarts 1/7/2021 and ends 2/4/2021. New session starts 2/4/21 and ends mid-April 2021.
