**Course repeat caution:** Students may only take a class or clinic once for a grade. A clinic may be taken a 2nd time by 3L or 4L students through the Clinical Education program elective if a student earns enough hours and the work is more complex. Superscript note explanations:

- 1 Legal Research & Writing (FEB) begins week of Feb 7, 2022 and ends mid-April, 2022; Introduction to Law (FEB) also begins week of Feb 7, 2022 and ends mid-April, 2022;
- 3 Legal Aid Clinic - option to take for 2 or 3 units
- 4 Clinical Education is available to 3rd- and 4th-year students only.
- 5 Disability Law Clinic is limited to 6 students. (Option to take for 1 or 2 or 3 units.)
- 6 Family Law Clinic (if offered - TBD) is limited to 1 or 2 students max.. (First three training class sessions meet 6:00 – 9:00 P.M.)
